If there are any problems that you are unable to solve on your own and the office is closed, please call 587-896-7529 to speak with a staff member who is monitoring the Emergency Phone Line. If the call reaches voicemail, please leave a message and reference the main page of Sportscentre for additional contact information, if your call is urgent.

WELCOME EVERYONE!

- *Introduce yourself and welcome everyone to the first day of the season.*
- *Explain your role (organizer for each night, you ensure that the courts get set-up properly, and report the scores to the CSSC so they can do the standings).*
- *Let everyone know that these announcements will take a few minutes, and that you appreciate their patience.*

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE LEAGUE: **(PLEASE READ OUT LOUD TO ENTIRE GROUP)**

- Throughout the season goal is to start as close to the time listed on the schedule; please plan to arrive 10-15 minutes early to prepare and help set up the gym.
- Captains: Please record your scores on the scoresheet after each game. *Show them where it will be located.*
- Reminders about respecting the facilities:
 - Remove outdoor footwear at entrances.
 - Wear non-scuffing shoes. Please do a scuff test right now to ensure your shoes are scuff free. If a mark is left behind, then those shoes cannot be worn. **This should be repeated each week, as different gyms have different floor types.**
 - Take all items with you including recycling and garbage.
- Reminders about defaults:
 - The minimum number of players to avoid a default is 4 – one of which must be female.
 - If this requirement isn't met by the time the first match is starting, teams will automatically lose the first game 0-25. They then have a 15-minute window to meet the requirements otherwise they will lose the second game 0-25, and effectively the entire match.
 - All teams will play two matches a night, which means it is possible to default one match but not the other.
 - If a team defaults, their opponents have a choice to charge the default fee. This is \$45/match (\$90 for an entire night). This fee will go to the opposing team as compensation for not playing a match.
 - If you are being defaulted against, please **state to your EC whether you want to collect this fee or not.**
 - The CSSC has sub lists accessible from your HomeBase account to help avoid defaults.
- Reminders about rules:
 - If there are any discrepancies between the rules, do not argue. Agree how you will call that rule for the rest of the match and re-serve the point.

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- A total of 5 points must be played in any game for it to count (i.e., 2-3, 5-0 are good). *If any thing less gets recorded, include it as a comment in your score report and omit it from the actual score entry.*
- Ties are allowed in regular season.
- Please familiarize yourself with your division specific descriptions and CSSC Volleyball Rules on your HomeBase Account.

START GAMES

- *Announce who is playing who on which court (you decide). Repeat for Match 2.*

GAME FORMAT

- *Matches are best of 3 games: rally point to 25, 25, and if necessary, 15.*
- *Games can be won by 1 point. In other words, first to 25 wins!*
- *A third game cannot be started if there is less than 5 minutes remaining in the match.*
- *Rock, Paper, Scissors for serve in the first and third games. The opposite team serves first in game 2.*
