WELCOME EVERYONE!

- *Introduce yourself and welcome everyone to the first week of the season.*
- *Explain your role (organizer for each week and report the scores to the CSSC so they can do the standings).*
- *Let everyone know that these announcements will take a few minutes, and that you appreciate their patience.*

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE LEAGUE:

- Captains: Please record your scores on the scoresheet after each game. *Show them where it will be located.*
- Reminders about defaults:
 - Summer 2025 Default Update: Default scores now include 3 matches, 0-11, 0-11, 0-11.
 - The minimum number of players to avoid a default is one – male or female.
 - If a team defaults, their opponents have a choice to charge the default fee. This is **\$30/match** (\$60 for an entire night). This fee will go to the opposing team as compensation for not playing a match.
 - If you are being defaulted against, please **state to your EC whether you want to collect this fee or not.**
 - The CSSC has sub lists accessible from your HomeBase account to help avoid defaults.
- Reminders about rules, violations, and faults:
 - Receiving players, please call any 'out of bounds' loudly and clearly.
 - If there is a dispute, re-serve with no point awarded.
 - Please respect the level of your opponents.
 - Summer 2025 Rule Update: Illegal Paddle List, CSSC has now implemented an illegal paddle list that can be found on HomeBase, check your opponent's paddles before the game and invite them to check yours; put aside any illegal paddles so they are not used during gameplay.
- Reminders about format and scores:
 - Each match will consist of 3 games, regardless of who won the first two.
 - For all three games, the first team to 11 points wins (must win by two points to a cap of 15).
 - Pickleball is not a rally-point scoring system. Points can only be scored by the team holding serve.
 - Ties are allowed in regular season.
 - Please visit the CSSC Pickleball page if you would like to view the full rule book.
- Reminders about serving:
 - The serving player should announce the score before each serve.
 - Announce the serving team's score first, followed by the opponents score, and then the server number.
 - *Example: 13-10-2 (indicates that the score is 13-10 for the serving team, and they are on their second server).*

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- The first serve of your team's possession always occurs in the right-hand service-court.

START GAMES

GAME FORMAT

- *Matches are mandatory 3 games: non-rally point to 11 for all games.*
- *Games must be won by 2 points but capped at 15.*
- *A third game cannot be started if there is less than 5 minutes remaining in the match.*
- *Rock, Paper, Scissors for serve in the first and third games. The opposite team serves first in game 2.*
