WELCOME EVERYONE!

- *Introduce yourself and welcome everyone to the first day of the season.*
- *Explain your role (organizer for each night, you ensure that everything is set up properly and report the scores to the CSSC so they can do the standings).*
- *Let everyone know that these Week 1 announcements will take a few minutes, and that you appreciate their patience.*

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT THE LEAGUE: (READ OUT LOUD TO ENTIRE GROUP)

- The goal is to start the games as close to the time listed on the schedule as possible; please plan to arrive 10-15 minutes early so we can get announcements read.
- Captains are responsible for recording scores. *Show then where the scoresheet will be located.*
- Reminders about the facility:
 - Please either remove outdoor footwear or ensure you are not tracking mud into the building.
- Reminder about the rules:
 - Teams will play one round per night, utilizing a stroke play, alternate shot format for the regular season and playoffs
 - Regular Season is Stroke Play – Focus is obtaining the lowest possible score, not outscoring the team playing with you
 - Teams will use one ball, taking alternate shots until the hole is completed.
 - Team members should take turns teeing off i.e., one player will take tee shots on odd-numbered holes, the other on even-numbered holes.
 - There may be cases where the simulator does not capture the shot taken by the player. This was not a fault of the player, so these strokes will not count. The player will simply reset their ball and hit again.
 - All putts will be auto putted at a distance of 10 ft. from the hole.
 - If your shot enters the 10 ft. radius of the hole, your ball will be automatically auto putted, and an additional stroke will be added to your score.
- Reminders about **defaults**:
 - To avoid a default in Simulator Golf, you need two people from each team to show up to each game. the default fee is \$45 per game. If you are unable to attend a game, you are responsible for finding a sub. You can access the CSSC subs list through your HomeBase account.
