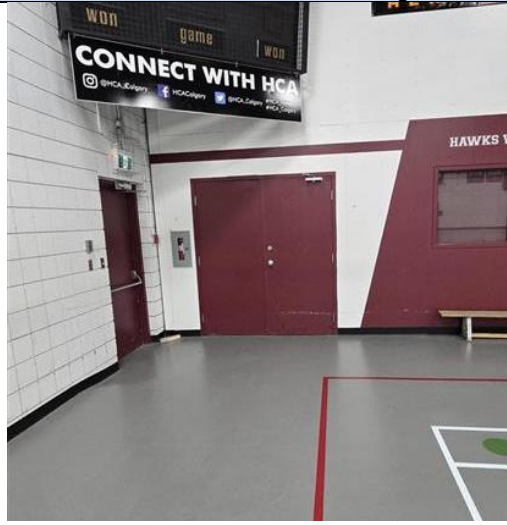

General Information

Parking: Players should park in the lot on the SE side of the school.

Entrance: Enter through the doors on the south side of the building, near the playground (the first set of clear glass doors). GC are required to utilize an app called Gallagher Mobile Connect to gain entry to the gym. When you are close enough to the door, open the app and select the actions button in the top right corner, from there, select 'Free – no PIN (as seen in photo 2) and it'll keep the door open for the night. When leaving for the night, open the app up and select lock.

Access will not be granted until 15 minutes to game time.

The gym entrance is immediately in front of the glass doors.

Gym Location: The gym is straight ahead through the burgundy doors as you enter the school. All GC's will need a key to gain access.

Field Location: Spikeball will be played on the sports field on the south side of the school, near the parking lot. There is a shed on the southwest side of the field with all of the Spikeball equipment.

Change room/Washroom: There are changerooms / washrooms located in the gym along the East wall as you enter the gym.

Floor: Should you notice the floor is a bit slippery, feel free to do a quick sweep of the floor. There is a micro-fibre broom behind the player bench on the Northeast corner of the gym. It is hanging on the wall in the small hallway.

Other:

The gym may be dark when you enter. There is a switch to shut off and turn on the lights. This switch is directly to the left of the Northeast Garage Door behind the curtain (in between the man door and the garage door). It will be under a glass case.

The score clock should be used to track the time and the score of the game. The school was very hesitant to give us this privilege, so we must be very careful.

If you decide to open the garage door for air, please ensure this is closed at the end of your shift. If you have trouble closing the doors, check the sensors as the bleachers will sometimes be pushed in front of the sensors. If you notice that the door still isn't shutting, you will need to manually push the sensor nearest the button on towards the garage door until a light turns orange. Once this light turns orange, you can hold the down button and the garage door will shut.

Equipment Location – Pickleball – Ball Hockey – Gym Soccer

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details: A wooden CSSC cabinet is kept in the equipment room in the photo above. Historically, the cabinet will not be locked inside of the storage room, but if for some reason it is, the combination is **6-20-26**.

The Ball hockey nets will be stored against the wall behind the player bench in the Northeast corner. Please ensure the nets are stacked nicely at the end of the night.

Gym Set-up

Basketball

Court Lines: Black basketball court lines, easily identifiable in this gym.

Player Benches: Players can sit on the benches against the wall outside the area of play.

Soccer

Goals: The posts and Nets are stored in the storage room located in the photo above. Set them up at either end of the gym.

Corner Boards / Player Benches: Player benches can be set up in the NE/NW corners of the gym.



Ball Hockey 4on4:

Nets: Use the full-size 72" hockey nets located against the wall in the NE corner of the gym.

Creases: There are no marked creases, however, you will find red vinyl tape in the storage cabinet if needed. Please ensure this tape is taken up at the end of the night.

Corner Boards: These need to be set-up in every corner as indicated in the diagram below. The 14ft corner boards go in the corners with the benches, and the shorter 6ft corner boards go in the other corners to round them off.

Player Benches: These need to be set-up inside of the corner boards (see diagram), players or bags should not be in the area of play. There should also be player benches in front of the divider to avoid a delay in play.

Obstructions: The basketball nets should be raised and out of the area of play but will likely not be a major obstruction on play. In seasons where we use the basketball nets regularly, they will remain down

Pickleball

Nets: There are pickleball nets in the storage room, they are in black bags labelled CSSC. There are six nets to set up in the gym across the courts.

Please put the nets back into the bags neatly and put them back into the storage room at the end of the night the way that you found them.

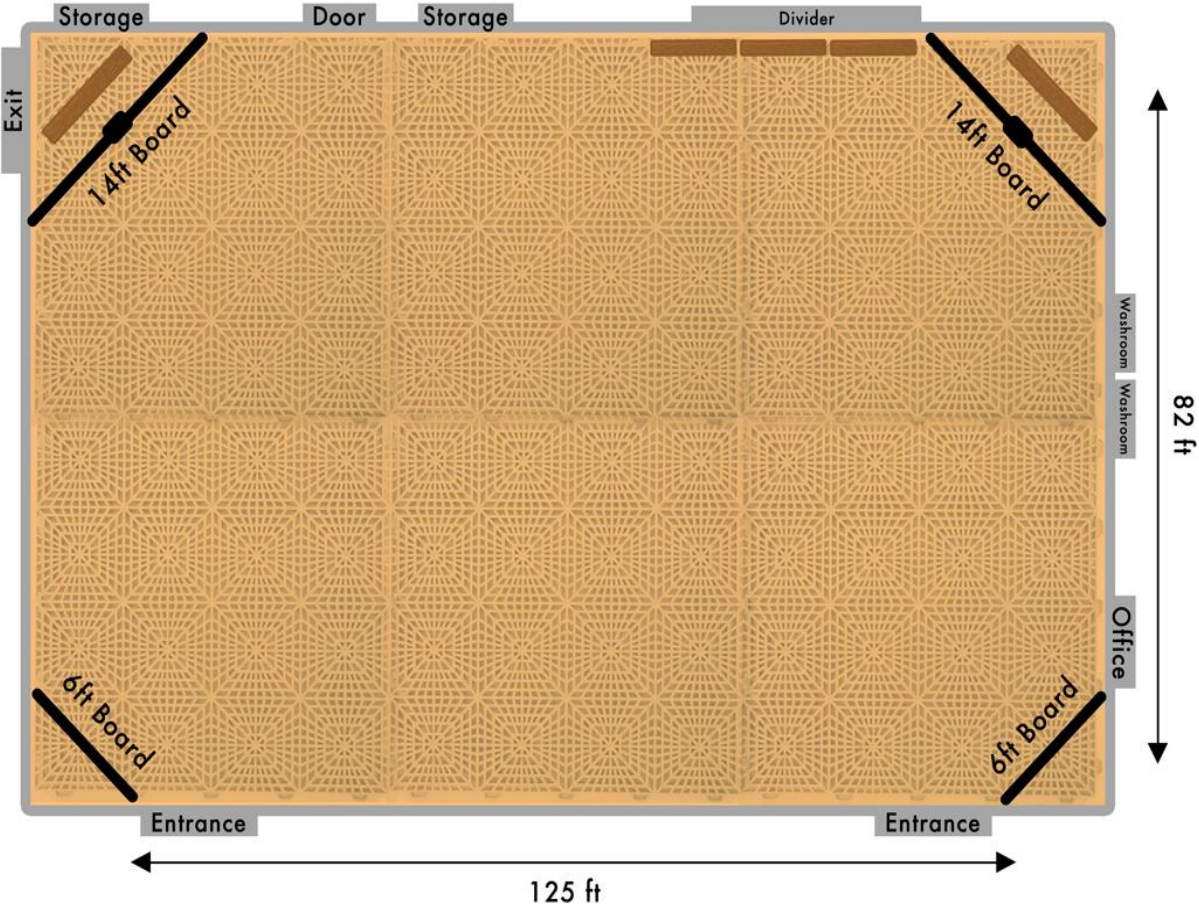
Spike Ball

Spikeball nets are located in a shed on the southwest side of the sports field across from the parking lot. Balls and nets will be stored in here. The code to the shed is 9078. Please ensure that the doors are closed properly at the end of the night. The door latches need to be shut properly before the lock can be put on the doors.

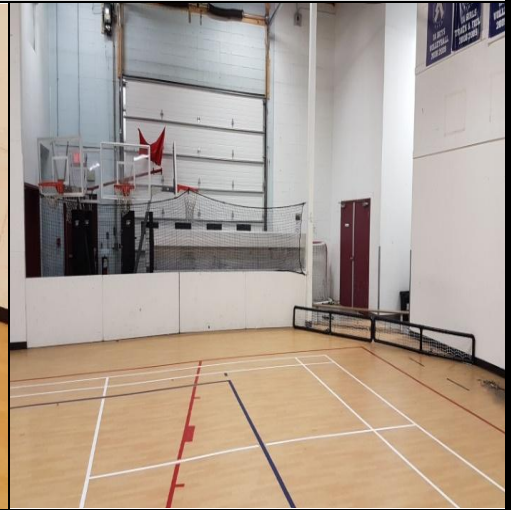
Ball Hockey 3on3:



14' boards for the SW/SE/NW/NE corners where players sit



6' boards for each of the corners along the divider - 4 in total



White wood board used behind the net and in front of the garage door. Black Netting attached to the hooks on the pillar and wall. Velcro used to hold middle up with basketball net rim.

Nets: Use the full-size 72" hockey nets in the storage room.

Creases: There are no marked creases for 3on3, however, you will find red vinyl tape in the storage cabinet. Please ensure this tape is taken up at the end of the night.

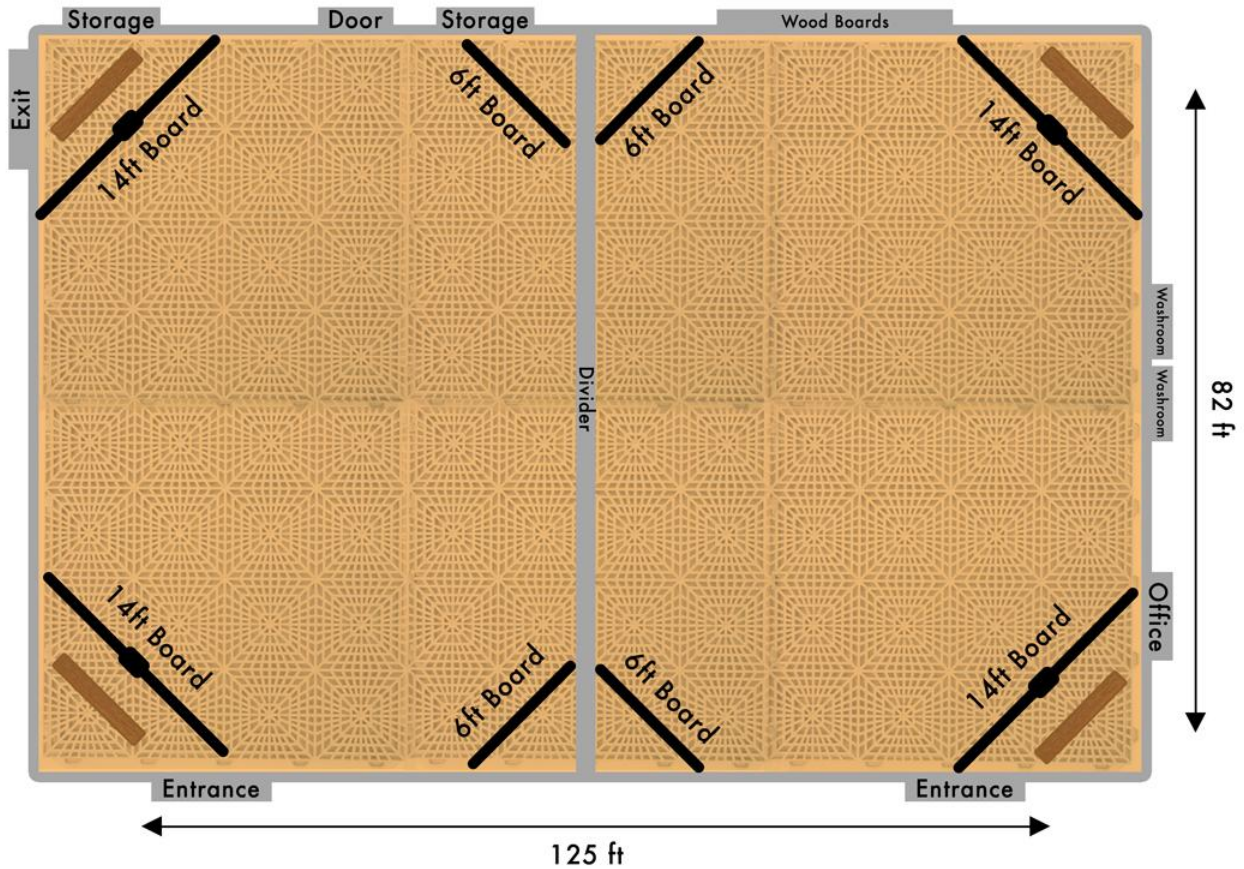
Corner Boards: These need to be set-up in every corner as indicated in the diagram below. The 14ft corner boards go in all 4 corners of the gym with the benches behind. The shorter 6ft corner boards go in each corner of the divider to keep the flow of the game consistent.

Player Benches: These need to be set-up inside of the corner boards (see diagram), players or bags should not be in the area of play. If you find you have an extra bench, please put it beside the bleachers closest to the garage door. You will also need to use the white wooden boards and the black netting behind the net and in front of the bleachers on the East side of the gym (see diagram). These boards are important to try and help the ball not go in to the bleacher area and delay the game.

Obstructions: The basketball nets should be raised and out of the area of play but will likely not be a major obstruction on play. In seasons where we use the basketball nets regularly, they will remain down!
