

JVC Return to Play Guidelines

General

- Everyone is required to sign 2 JVC one-time waivers
 - [Participation Waiver](#)
 - [Facility Waiver](#)
- Water fountains will not be available to users; however, touchless bottle filling stations will remain open.
- Food and eating is not permitted in JVC at this time.
- NO spectators are permitted.

Masks

- Masks are required. You may remove their masks once they arrive at their assigned court. Masks are required while walking to and from your court, filling up water bottles and using the washrooms.

Arrival and Departure

- All individuals will undergo a **daily wellness check** which includes a questionnaire and temperature check by a JVC staff member or CSSC coordinator. Players will NOT be permitted to enter JVC if they have a fever or if they do not pass the wellness check.
- Everyone who enters JVC will be required to sign the daily log book with their name and contact information as a part of our Emergency Action Plan.
- Upon entry, all users will be required to immediately sanitize their hands (sanitizer stations are situated in the foyer).
- If the front gate is closed or if a JVC staff member is not at the front desk, **you are not permitted to enter.**
- Visitors are required to follow all marked directional guides, this includes one-way lanes and court entry points. Cutting across other courts is not permitted.

Locker Rooms & Washrooms

- Locker rooms will be closed, please come dressed and ready to play.
- Outdoor shoes are still required to be removed. Shoe storage is still available. Users are encouraged to put their outdoor shoes in their bags and bring them inside. Indoor shoes can be put on once on the court.
- Washrooms will be open, but a limited number of people will be permitted at a time to allow for physical distancing.
