## CSSC Illegal Bat List – Updated November 2017

Any bat listed below is considered illegal in all CSSC Slo-Pitch leagues. Players caught using illegal bats may face suspension or ejection. Please ensure these three guidelines are followed at every game:

- Print the illegal bat list and bring to each game.
- Check your opponent's bats before the game and invite them to check yours; put aside any illegal bats so they are not used in the game.
- Please use only the yellow DeMarini softballs (each team gets 3 free ones per 8 week season) provided by the CSSC; these are designed to travel less distance. If you ever need a new one, just come down to our office.
- As of January 1, 2013, bats must have either one or a combination of these stamps (See below). Any bats not having these stamps will be considered illegal. If the bat has these stamps and are seen in the list below, they are still considered illegal. **This includes composite** and/or wooden bats.




