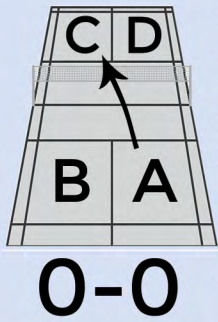
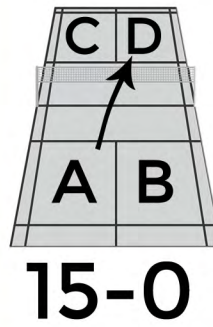


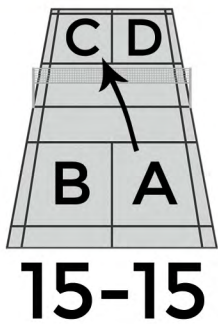
This is an example of a doubles Tennis match between teams A & B and C & D.



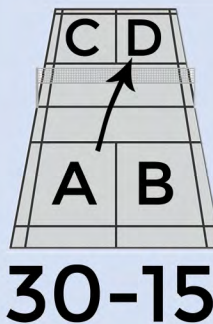
**Scenario:**  
 - A & B win the coin toss and choose to serve first.  
 - A serves from the right service court.  
**Score:** 0-0  
**Service:** Serving from the **Right Service Court.**  
**Server & Receiver:** A serves to C.  
**Winner:** A & B



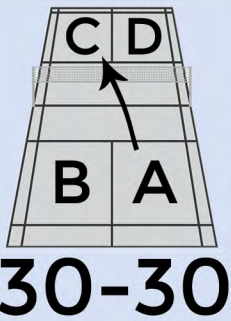
**Score:** 15-0  
**Service:** Serving from the **Left Service Court.**  
**Server & Receiver:** A serves to D.  
 C & D do not move.  
**Winner:** C & D



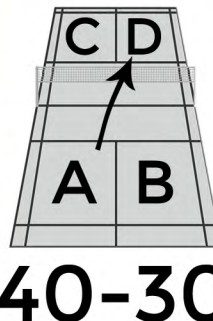
**Score:** 15-15  
**Service:** Serving from the **Right Service Court.**  
**Server & Receiver:** A serves to C.  
**Winner:** A & B



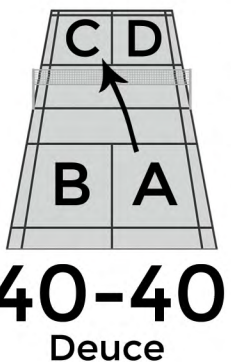
**Score:** 30-15  
**Service:** Serving from the **Left Service Court.**  
**Server & Receiver:** A serves to D.  
**Winner:** C & D



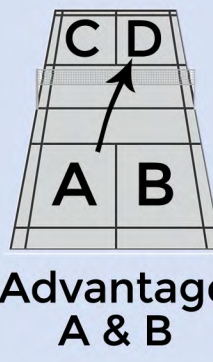
**Score:** 30-30  
**Service:** Serving from the **Right Service Court.**  
**Server & Receiver:** A serves to C.  
**Winner:** C & D



**Score:** 40-30  
**Service:** Serving from the **Left Service Court.**  
**Server & Receiver:** A serves to D.  
**Winner:** A & B



**Score:** 40-40 = Deuce  
**Service:** Serving from the **Right Service Court.**  
**Server & Receiver:** A serves to C.  
**Winner:** A & B



**Score:** Advantage A & B  
**Service:** Serving from the **Left Service Court.**  
**Server & Receiver:** A serves to D.  
**Game Winner:** A & B

The server will switch service courts every point, regardless of which team won the previous rally.
