Rules & Format	Details
Roster	• 5 players on the court (including goalie), minimum of 2 females
	Minimum to not default: 4 players, at least 1 female
Mercy	• Mercy is called and the score freezes if a team gains a 13-point lead.
Game time	Two 25 minute halves with a 5 minute half time
	• The game will begin the game with a throw-off at half court. Each team
Game Start &	must be on their own half and 3 meters away from the ball. The team that
Subbing	didn't win the throw-off will get the throw off for the 2 nd half
	Sub on the fly
	• Defensive players may pass through their own crease but must clear out
	within 3 seconds
Creases	• Offensive players are not allowed in their opponent's crease, except if
	they are landing from a jump shot started outside of the crease
	Goalies cannot leave their crease
	 Goals are not allowed if the shooting player was in the crease After a goal, the game continues with the goalie just second on putting the
Scoring	 After a goal, the game continues with the goalie just scored on putting the ball back into play vs. a restart at half
	 Goalies can score
	 When a player receives the ball, they can: be stationary with the ball for 3
	seconds (pivot steps included as stationary), dribble as many times as they
	want, pass, shoot or take 3 steps holding on to the ball
	• You cannot double-dribble, after a dribble is picked up, a player cannot
	dribble again
	• A failed pass resulting in the ball hitting the ground is dead, with
	possession going to the other team
Possession &	• If a defender intercepts a ball either by catching, or blocking, even if it hits
Turnovers	the ground, it will remain the defensive team's ball
	• When the ball is dropped/turnover occurs the team gaining possession
	must pass at least once before shooting
	• When offensive player (with or without the ball) enters the crease, the ball goes to the defending team
	 When the ball goes out of bounds the team that did not touch the ball last
	is awarded a throw-in. All throw-ins are indirect
	 A ball going out off bounds last touched by the goalie will be rewarded a
	corner ball
	• A defending player cannot: make contact, hold, hit, trip, reach in on an
	offensive player
	• If a defending player interferes with a goal scoring opportunity by fouling
Violations	a player, the player who was fouled is awarded a penalty shot
	• If a defensive player contacts the ball while in their own crease, the other
	team will be awarded a penalty shot
	A free-throw is awarded for the team fouled when an infraction occurs
