## Rules \& Format

Details

| Roster | - 5 players on the court (including goalie), minimum 2 females <br> - Minimum not to default: 4 players 1 female |

| Mercy | - Mercy is called and the score freezes if a team gains a 7-point lead. |
| Game time | - Two 25 minute halves with a 5 minute half time |
| Game start \& subbing | - A kick off starts the game and restarts play after a goal is scored <br> - Kickoffs do not need to travel forwards, but the ball cannot be touched by the kicker again until another player contacts the ball <br> - Sub on the fly |
| Area of Play | - All areas are 'live' (walls, doors, etc) <br> - Ball is 'Out of Play' when it hits the ceiling, curtains, or goes under a team bench |
| Creases/Goalie Areas | - Players are not allowed to stay stationary inside their own, or their opponents' crease <br> - Players can run through the crease if they do not interfere with the goalie, and do not touch the ball while in the crease <br> - Goalies are the only player that can play the ball in the crease |
| Goalies | - Can use their hands only inside their own crease <br> - Goalies can handle a pass with their feet or hands <br> - Goalies have 5 seconds to get the ball back in play after a save <br> - Cannot go over half, but can score <br> - Cannot be pulled for an extra player |
| Ball in the Corner | - When two players are chasing the ball into the corner from a far distance, the player leading within 5 feet of the corner will gain possession of the ball and the opponent must stop and give their opponent 5 feet of space, and 3 seconds to play the ball. If there is no clear leading play, possession goes to the defensive player. |
| Free Kicks | - All free kicks are indirect, meaning a goal cannot be directly scored |
| Advantage Rule | - When a foul occurs but the team fouled against is not disadvantaged by the play the play can continue with no consequence <br> - The advantage rule is called at the GC's discretion |
| Handballs | - When the ball touches any part of a player's arm from the bottom of the shoulder to the finger tips a handball will be called (except for a goalie in their own crease) <br> - If there is a handball but the opposing team is not adversely affected play can continue |
| Slide Tackling | - NO slide tackles are allowed in SSC leagues. <br> - Includes any player, or goalie, leaving the ground in a feet-forward motion toward the ball or another player |
