

## GYM SOCCER Format & Rey Rules



Rules & Format	Details
Roster	<ul> <li>5 players on the court (including goalie), minimum 2 females</li> <li>Minimum not to default: 4 players 1 female</li> </ul>
Mercy	Mercy is called and the score freezes if a team gains a 7-point lead.
Game time	Two 25 minute halves with a 5 minute half time
Game start & subbing	<ul> <li>A kick off starts the game and restarts play after a goal is scored</li> <li>Kickoffs do not need to travel forwards, but the ball cannot be touched by the kicker again until another player contacts the ball</li> <li>Sub on the fly</li> </ul>
Area of Play	<ul> <li>All areas are 'live' (walls, doors, etc)</li> <li>Ball is 'Out of Play' when it hits the ceiling, curtains, or goes under a team bench</li> </ul>
Creases/Goalie Areas	<ul> <li>Players are not allowed to stay stationary inside their own, or their opponents' crease</li> <li>Players can run through the crease if they do not interfere with the goalie, and do not touch the ball while in the crease</li> <li>Goalies are the only player that can play the ball in the crease</li> </ul>
Goalies	<ul> <li>Can use their hands only inside their own crease</li> <li>Goalies can handle a pass with their feet or hands</li> <li>Goalies have 5 seconds to get the ball back in play after a save</li> <li>Cannot go over half, but can score</li> <li>Cannot be pulled for an extra player</li> </ul>
Ball in the Corner	• When two players are chasing the ball into the corner from a far distance, the player leading within 5 feet of the corner will gain possession of the ball and the opponent must stop and give their opponent 5 feet of space, and 3 seconds to play the ball. If there is no clear leading play, possession goes to the defensive player.
Free Kicks	All free kicks are indirect, meaning a goal cannot be directly scored
Advantage Rule	<ul> <li>When a foul occurs but the team fouled against is not disadvantaged by the play the play can continue with no consequence</li> <li>The advantage rule is called at the GC's discretion</li> </ul>
Handballs	<ul> <li>When the ball touches any part of a player's arm from the bottom of the shoulder to the finger tips a handball will be called (except for a goalie in their own crease)</li> <li>If there is a handball but the opposing team is not adversely affected play can continue</li> </ul>
Slide Tackling	<ul> <li>NO slide tackles are allowed in SSC leagues.</li> <li>Includes any player, or goalie, leaving the ground in a feet-forward motion toward the ball or another player</li> </ul>
